One common Sendmail configuration is to have a single machine act as a mail gateway for all machines on the network. For instance, a company may want to have a machine calledmail.example.com that handles all of their email and assigns a consistent return address to all outgoing mail.

In this situation, the Sendmail server must masquerade the machine names on the company network so that their return address is user@example.com instead of user@host.example.com.

To do this, add the following lines to /etc/mail/sendmail.mc:

- FEATURE(always_add_domain)dnl
- FEATURE(`masquerade_entire_domain')dnl
- / FEATURE(`masquerade_envelope')dnl
- / FEATURE(`allmasquerade')dnl
- MASQUERADE_AS(`bigcorp.com.')dnl
- MASQUERADE_DOMAIN(`bigcorp.com.')dnl
- MASQUERADE_AS(bigcorp.com)dnl
